Change in Conditions on English Course Enrollment
Master of Management Program (International Program)

With reference to the Announcement of International College, National Institute of Development Administration, on the Conditions on English Course Enrollment, announced on July 13, 2013, and to facilitate the teaching activities due to the addition of the language taught in the program, the conditions on English course enrollment for the Master of Management Program (International Program), International College, have been changed as followed.

The applicants admitted to the College must enroll in an English course organized by the College. Exception can be granted under one of the following conditions.

1. The applicants have obtained Bachelor's and/or Master's degree from academic institutions in a country where English is an official language or
2. The applicants are native English speakers or
3. The applicants hold a test score from either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), the Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC), or TOEFL/ITP (Institutional Testing Program).

For English Language Program: the minimum TOEFL or TOEFL/ITP score is 525 (paper-and pencil), 196 (computer-based), and 69 - 70 (Internet-based), or IELTS score of at least 5.5, or TOEIC score of 600 obtained within two years prior to the application.

For Chinese Language Program: the minimum TOEFL or TOEFL/ITP score is 500 (paper-and pencil), 173 (computer-based), and 59 - 60 (Internet-based), or IELTS score of at least 5.0, or TOEIC score of 500 obtained within two years prior to the application.

The conditions are effective for the students enrolling in the second semester of academic year 2022 onwards.
