

1. A bachelor's degree and/or a master's degree in the study program(s) taught in English provided that the applicants have graduated no more than 5 years prior to the start of the first semester of registration as **regular students** with a cumulative grade point average of no less than 2.75 in bachelor's degree and 3.25 in master's degree or
2. A native English speaker who is also a resident and permanent resident of an English-speaking country; or
3. An Internet-based TOEFL (iBT) score of 79 or higher, or a TOEFL ITP test score administered by the Center for Language and Communication Development and Service, Graduate School of Language and Communication of 550 or higher or IELTS score of 6.5 or higher. However, the test result must not be from the test taken more than 2 years prior to the first registration date as a regular student.
